### **Titles of Pastoral Leaders**

Pastoral leaders are those who tend to the flock. Their work is very crucial because it is taking care of the people of God. It is work entrusted by Jesus, the Chief Shepherd.

Household Servant (in lieu of Household Head)  
Unit Servant  
Chapter Servant  
Cluster Servant  
District Servant <sup>1</sup>  
Country Servant <sup>2</sup>

For other leaders and positions, the former titles remain. <sup>3</sup>
